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## *Vespa Bianco, Bastianich, Friuli 2012 70*

An elegant, medium to full bodied white, with flavors of honey baked pear, lemon preserves and a creamy finish. Chardonnay, Sauvignon Blanc and Picolit.

## *Chardonnay, Vie di Romans, Friuli 2014 75*

A spectacular expression of the grape that is generous & loaded with character. The barrique-aged wine is creamy and rich with buttery almond, honey, orange peel & crushed mineral on the nose.

At the same time, the wine appears surprisingly lightweight, crisp and silky in texture.

In terms of Chardonnay, this wine offers the full package.

## *Gavi, Michele Chiarlo, Piemonte 2016 46*

The wine shows citrus and mineral aromas before lime and green apple flavors on the palate.

Bright and crisp white with a hot stone and tangy lime character. Medium body, vibrant acidity and a long and flavorful finish. Real Gavi.

## *Roero Arneis, Bruno Giacosa, Piemonte 2016 65*

This is a fresh and buoyant wine that is loaded with tangy tropical fruit, pineapple & honeydew melon. The wine's intensity is exuberant, pronounced & refreshing. Dustings of fine mineral & salty limestone characteristics give the wine a brilliant sense of polish and crispness.

## *Chardonnay, Cavallotto, Langhe, Piemonte 2015 55*

The 2015 vintage brought forth a Chardonnay of ripe, lush mouth feel, full of aromas and flavors of pears, peaches and white melon. Fruit dominates this warmer vintage, but the balanced acid profile keeps everything well-structured.

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## *Pinot Grigio, Livio Felluga, Friuli 2016 50*

Brilliant yellow with rosy & coppery tones. Ample, complex & sweet nose with notes of pear, orange blossoms, & hint of spices; intriguing development & an aromatic finish with significant persistence. The palate is full & embracing, the subtle notes of pear & nectarine brings amplitude, fresh and savory all at once with pleasant minerality on the finish. Green-friendly vineyard.

## *Arneis, Damilano, Langhe, Piemonte 12 glass / 44 bottle*
