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## ***Pinot Noir, Walt 'Blue Jay', Anderson Valley 2016 75***

From Anderson Valley in the northern part of California, the 2016 Blue Jay offers a similar smoky, meaty profile as well as medium-bodied richness, light tannin, and a charming, elegant style on the palate.

## ***Castello di Volpaia Chianti Classico Riserva 2014 60***

Though saturated with black currant and blackberry fruit this red is pure and balanced. Full body with lots of tannins and hazelnuts. Compact and brooding and a very powerful style for Volpaia.

## ***Rosso Stupore, Campo Alle Comete 2015 75***

A blend of 50% Merlot, 25% Syrah, 20% Petit Verdot and 5% Cabernet Sauvignon Aged in oak for 12 months. The wine is very generous in terms of its dark fruit nuances & it shows lingering tones of spice and balsam herb at the back. Medium to full body, fine tannins and a fruity finish.

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## ***Cabernet Sauvignon, Faust, Napa Valley 2015 120***

Mainly Cabernet with splashes of Merlot, Cabernet Franc & Petit Verdot. A dense yet fresh red with a blueberry & blackberry character, hints of tobacco and dark chocolate. The body is full & the fruit is generous. This is a big wine playing on ripe tannins & strength, but underneath all of that are some lovely cinnamon and baked plum flavors. Layered and beautiful. Juicy fruit at the finish.

## ***Pinot Noir, Brewer-Clifton, Santa Rita Hills, Santa Barbara, California 2015 75***

Incredibly dynamic & delicious. A fresh, fruity strawberry-slushe aroma is met with notes of crushed slate and star anise-spiced cookies on the nose. The palate is bright in flavors of slightly tart cherries and ripe cranberries, but then come juniper on the midpalate.

Acidity pumps into the pomegranate finish.

## ***Le Volte Dell' Ornellaia, Toscana 2016 16 gl. | 58 bt.***

Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot and Sangiovese.

Black currant & blackberry aromas and flavors mark this firm, linear red. Fruity yet savory, ending with a dense, wide swath of tannins. A delicious juicy finish.
