Merlot, Thorn by The Prisoner, Napa Valley 2013 85

A firm structure combines with ripe, plush fruit to make a winning Merlot. Aromas of currant, espresso and grilled herb open to complex flavors framed by ripe tannins. Drink now through 2024.

Wine Spectator 91 points

Cabernet Sauvignon, Hall, Napa Valley 2014 120

Dark and rich, with explosive dark berry, mocha, licorice, cedar and crushed rock touches, tilting toward herbal underbrush notes on the finish but never losing focus on the fruit. Drink now.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Silver Oak, Alexander Valley 2013 140

Pure, rich and firm, with an enticing core of blackberry, black olive, dill and herb flavors, ending with a cedary oak edge. Impressive for the mix of intensity and balance.

Wine Spectator 90 points / Decanter 94 points

Etna Rosso, Tornatore, Sicilia 2016 14 gl. | 50 bt.

Very finely textured with rose-petals, strawberries and light cedar.

Medium body. Caressing and beautiful. Drink now.

Brunello di Montalcino, La Colombina, Toscana 2013 90

A fleshy and complete expression of Sangiovese that shows staying power and balanced intensity.

This wine would pair perfectly next to meats or homemade pasta with game sauce (wild boar).

I like the smooth intensity displayed by this wine as it glides cleanly over the palate.

Robert Parker 92 points

Cabernet Sauvignon, Orin Swift's 'Palermo', Napa Valley 2015 85

Mainly Cabernet Sauvignon with splashes of Merlot & Malbec. Opens with notions of crushed red currants, blackberries & mulberries with touches of Indian spices. Medium to full-bodied, the palate has a wonderfully spicy undercurrent, loads of red and black fruits & a chewy frame, finishing long and perfumed.

Wine Advocate 91 points

Pinot Noir, Brewer-Clifton, Santa Rita Hills, Santa Barbara, California 2015 75

Incredibly dynamic & delicious. A fresh, fruity strawberry-slushie aroma is met with notes of crushed slate and star anise-spiced cookies on the nose. The palate is bright in flavors of slightly tart cherries and ripe cranberries, but then come juniper on the midpalate.

Acidity pumps into the pomegranate finish.
