Hints of minerality with lively honey crisp apple & lemon flavors.
Offers a sleek, minerally finish.*

Sauvignon Blanc, Duckhorn, Napa Valley 2017 36

Elegant peach, melon & citrus flavors are juicy & plump, with a pretty floral vein & a sleek, crisp frame. A note of lemon verbena lingers.

Chardonnay, Cakebread Cellars, Napa Valley 2017 50

*This wine represents Napa Valley like few other white wines.
It is rich, layered, & rewarding. Its aromas & flavors of
ripe Golden Delicious apple & subtle oaky notes.*

Pinot Noir, Sonoma Cutrer, Russian River Valley 2016 36

A neatly cut array of refined red & black cherries in a pristinely cast style. The palate has an elegant & neatly defined core of supple, long & ripe fruit flavor & carries a wealth of crisp, fresh, cherry-soaked tannins at the finish.

Brunello di Montalcino, Mocali, Toscana 2013 50

A dark & savory expression of Sangiovese from one of the most beautiful corners of Tuscany. This is a dark & velvety wine that is packed tight with black fruit flavors & spice. It shows texture in the mouth & firm grip.

Cabernet Sauvignon, Faust, Napa Valley 2017 65

A dense yet fresh red with a blueberry & blackberry character & hints of tobacco & dark chocolate. Light bitterness adds to the complexity on the palate. Layered & beautiful. Juicy fruit at the finish.
